CLIENT COMMUNICATOR: – Providing information / Answering your questions. Past topics: *What is Violent Death; Manner and Cause of Death / What is DNA. THIS MONTH - Why Varying Times of Death?*

ACTUAL – The time a person’s heart stops beating (only certain when a person dies in the presence of a physician, etc.).
PRONOUNCED – As determined by a death-authorized person: physician / paramedic / field medical investigator.
PRESUMED / INVESTIGATIVE - Estimated by trained personnel based on conditions of the body (rigor mortis / lividity / core body temperature / decomposition / other). All factors can vary by circumstances and it can be disputed.
 The time elapsed from when death occurs until the body is found is known as Postmortem Interval – PMI.
 Most medical investigators use the “Pronounced Time” to enter into the death certificate.
